## Publicity/ events since last board meeting --

*Hendo Earth Fest* – I delivered the informative hand-out (requested by Glenn Lange) and updated Tree Board brochure to the Tree Board table at the event, took some photos, and discussed new display ideas for the Tree Board table for next year.

Bradford Pear Bounty Program – We received excellent media coverage and a healthy response from Henderson County residents. Registration slots filled up quickly.
