

Library Director's Report Marianne Beck Memorial Library For the Month of May 2024

Statistics for May 2024

Digital: 162, KOHA: 1,856 **Total:** 2,018. Items borrowed from other libraries: 454, items loaned to other libraries: 393. There were 89 computer sessions in May. Cloud library, which will be replacing Libby within the year had 212 checkouts. 8 residents received new library cards. A total of 4,714 residents visited the library in May. The library has 13,384 items in our collection.

Lake County Library System Update:
