Re: Consideration and Approval: **Authorization for Mayor Wells to execute approved**

Ordinance 2015-005

Objective:

The objective of this agenda item is to seek Town Council's authorization for Mayor Graham Wells to execute Ordinance 2015-005, which was approved by the Town Council on January 25, 2016, but inadvertently left unsigned. Ordinance 2015-005 amends the conceptual land use plan for the Lake Hills Mixed Planned Unit Development (originally adopted via Ordinance 2011-008). This action ensures proper execution and adherence to statutory requirements, thereby formalizing the ordinance and maintaining the integrity of the Town's legislative processes

Summary:

This agenda item seeks Town Council's authorization for Mayor Graham Wells to execute Ordinance 2015-005, which was approved on January 25, 2016, but inadvertently left unsigned. Ordinance 2015-005 amends the conceptual land use plan for the Lake Hills Mixed Planned Unit Development to reflect changes necessitated by the applicant. Execution of the ordinance is required to finalize its adoption, ensure compliance with statutory requirements, and uphold the validity of the Town's legislative actions. This corrective measure reinforces the Town's commitment to transparency and proper procedural practices.
