1 ORDINANCE NO. 2024-010 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF HOWEY-IN-THE-HILLS, 4 FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO TOWN COUNCIL; REVISING THE 5 COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE MAYOR, MAYOR PRO 6 TEMPORE AND COUNCILORS UNDER SECTION 42-10 OF THE 7 TOWN'S CODE OF **ORDINANCES**; **PROVIDING FOR** 8 SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9 10 11 Whereas, Subsection 112.313(5) of the Florida Statutes provides that the Town Council 12 members may vote on matters affecting their salary, expenses, or other compensation as a public 13 officer. 14 15 Whereas, the Town Council now desires to amend the Town's Code of Ordinances 16 regarding the amount of compensation paid to the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tempore, and Councilors. 17 18 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HOWEY-19 **IN-THE-HILLS, FLORIDA:** 20 21 **Section 1. Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are true and correct and constitute the 22 legislative findings of the Town Council. 23 24 Section 2. Amendments to the Town of Howev-in-the-Hills' Code of Ordinances. Section 25 42-10 of the Town of Howey-in-the-Hills Code of Ordinances is amended, as shown by the addition of the underlined language and the deletion of the struck-through language, as follows: 26 27 28 Sec. 42-10. - Compensation of the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tempore and Town Council 29 Members. 30 31 A. The Mayor shall receive compensation in the amount of \$125.00\\$250.00 per Town 32 Council meeting, workshop, or specially called meeting attended by the Mayor. The 33 Mayor's compensation shall not exceed \$250.00\\$500.00 per calendar month. B. The Mayor Pro Tempore shall receive compensation in the amount of \$62.50\\$125.00 per 34 35 Town Council meeting, workshop, or specially called meeting attended by the Mayor Pro Tempore. The Mayor Pro Tempore compensation shall not exceed \$125.00\frac{\$250.00}{250.00} per 36 37 calendar month. 38 C. A Town Councilor shall receive compensation in the amount of \$50.00\\$100.00 per town 39 council meeting, workshop, or specially called meeting attended by a Town Councilor. A 40 Town Councilor's compensation shall not exceed \$100.00\\$200.00 per calendar month. 41 D. The Mayor may be excused from attending a town council meeting, workshop, or 42 specially called meeting without a deduction in compensation. The Mayor must notify the Town Clerk 24 hours prior to the meeting. The Town Clerk shall announce the Mayor's 43 44 absence at the meeting, and the Town Council shall determine whether the absence will be deemed excused for purposes of this paragraph. 45

46 47 48 49 50 51	<ul> <li>E. The Mayor Pro Tempore or a Town Councilor may be excused from attending a town council meeting, workshop or specially called meeting without a deduction in compensation. The Mayor Pro Tempore or Town Councilor wishing to be excused from meeting must notify the Mayor 24 hours prior to the meeting, at which time the Mayor shall determine whether the absence will be deemed excused for purposes of this paragraph.</li> <li>Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this ordinance, but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.</li> </ul>
