

Library Director's Report Marianne Beck Memorial Library For the Month of February 2023

Statistics for February 2023

KOHA: 1,613, Digital: 200 total KOHA: 1,813. Computer sessions: 47, Wi-Fi 53.64. The library has 12,872 items. The library loaned to other libraries: 301, borrowed: 441 the library was opened 23 days in January.

Activities during the month of February:

The BCC voted to defer the impact fee grant applications until 2024 as a consultant is being hired to help rewrite the application. George Taylor, Director of Library Services, has presented to the BCC to raise the member library appropriations to a base \$25,000.00. If approved by the BCC, it would go into effect September 2023.

The LEC's use continue to grow. In March we will host 44 programs and seminars in the LEC. We also have 6 programs in the main library. Our programming continues to expand. In the month of March we will be offering a Drone as well as a 3d printer class, another American Girl book club meeting and a senior technology class.

I have begun to order the books from 2022 Impact Fee Grant for a home school collection. It will be a long process but I hope to have it completed in 4 to 5 months.
