

Library Director's Report Marianne Beck Memorial Library For the Month of November 2024

Statistics for November 2024:

Digital: 571, KOHA: 3,403 **Total:** 3,974. Items borrowed from other libraries: 403, items loaned to other libraries: 302. There were 49 computer sessions in November. 9 residents received new library cards. A total of 5,408 residents visited the library in November. The current holdings in our library are 14,150.

Lake County Library System Update:

There will be no Library Director's meeting in December due the State Library Public Director's Assembly in Tallahassee; December 12th and 13th. In January the Directors will begin to discuss possible impact fee applications for 2025.

Activities during the month of November:

Election Day saw 771 residents vote at our library. 40 local school age kids attended the Neon Ball dance held on November 14th. Both home school and public school kids attended this event that raised \$180 for the Friends of the Library. The AARP used the LEC for tax training in November. The Yoga and Zumba classes have increased in attendance. The other monthly programs are going well also.

Total Program Attendance for November: 316 patrons. The library closed for 4 days in November due to holidays.
