- 1. The water system calculations still need to be revised and resubmitted. The analyzed system needs to include the proposed offsite water mains up to the tie-in points on the town's system. The pressures at the tie-in should be those from the flow test provided by the town. Provide a pipe schematic overlayed on the subdivision plan and the offsite main extensions. Show the input data for the model including the demand calculations and the pressures at the tie-in points.
- 2. The lift station plan needs to identify the model of Hydromatic pump to be used.
- 3. Provide updated lift station calculations.
- 4. On the lift station tract layout show the required hose bib with the water service going to it. The hose bib needs to be located near the wet well & valve box on the side towards the control panel.
- 5. Provide offsite utility plans for review and approval.
- 6. The developer and the Town need to coordinate on the offsite utility connection points.
- 7. All curb ramps need to have ADA compliant detectible warning pads serving all crosswalks.
- 8. Add the town's road sign detail. Add a note to the plans that the Lake County road sign is only applicable for Buckhill Road. Add to the layout plan street name signs at the road connections to Buckhill.
- 9. No construction shall commence until all applicable outside agency permits are provided to the Town.
- 10. Additional comments may be added to these with the reviews of subsequent submittals.
