

Library Director's Report Marianne Beck Memorial Library For the Month of October 2024

Statistics for October 2024:

Digital: 281, KOHA: 1,840 **Total:** 2,121. Items borrowed from other libraries: 398, items loaned to other libraries: 403. There were 78 computer sessions in September. 18 residents received new library cards. A total of 4,258 residents visited the library in October. The current holdings in our library are 14,008.

Lake County Library System Update:

There will be no Library Director's meeting in December due the State Library Public Director's Assembly in Tallahassee; December 12th and 13th. In January the Directors will begin to discuss possible impact fee applications for 2025.
