The library saw a steady flow of patrons this month, with a total of 2,700 physical and digital items checked out. This was an increase from the previous month's circulation number of 2035.

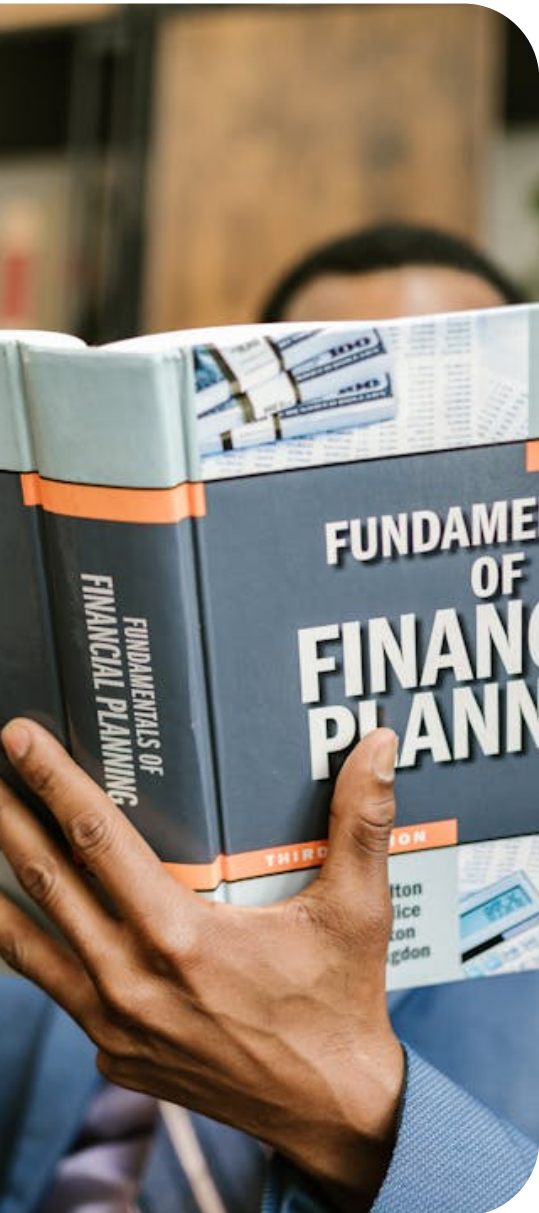


The most popular categories were fiction, non-fiction, and audiobooks, highlighting the library's role in providing a variety of reading materials.
