PETITION FOR DECLARATORY JUDGEMENT

COMES NOW, Terri L. Cook Wunder, Executor of the Estate of Mary Lou Cook, and in support of this Petition for Declaratory Judgement hereby states as follows:

INTRODUCTION

- 1. This is an action by Terri L. Cook Wunder, serving in her capacity as the Executor of the Estate of Mary Lou Cook, seeking a declaratory judgment to interpret the terms of the Last Will and Testament of Mary Lou Cook regarding distribution to the Independence Public Library.
- 2. Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 633.11, during the administration of an estate, the district court sitting in probate shall have full, legal and equitable powers to make declaratory judgments in all matters involved in the administration of the estate, including those pertaining to the title of real estate, the determination of heirship, and the distribution of the estate. It shall have full, legal and equitable powers to enter final orders and decrees in all probate matters to effectuate its jurisdiction and to carry out its orders, judgments and decrees.

JURISDICTION

- 3. The district court sitting in probate has exclusive jurisdiction of proceedings concerning the internal affairs of an estate. See Iowa Code Section 633.10.
- 4. Venue is proper in Buchanan County, as pursuant to Iowa Code Section 633.12, a proceeding may be commenced in the county in which the estate's principal place of administration is or is to be located and if the estate is created by will, also in the county in which the decedent's estate is administered. Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 633.10, the principal place of administration of an estate is the usual place where the day-to-day activity of the estate is carried on by the executor or the executor's representative who is primarily responsible for the administration of the estate. Terri L. Cook Wunder is the Executor of the Estate of Mary Lou Cook, which is being administered in Buchanan County, Iowa.

FACTS

- 5. Mary Lou Cook executed a Last Will and Testament ("Will"), attached hereto as Exhibit A, on August 14, 2018.
 - 6. Mary Lou Cook passed away on September 10, 2024.

- 7. The Estate of Mary Lou Cook is pending in the Iowa District Court for Buchanan County as Case No ESPR008210. The Will has been admitted to probate in the proceedings.
- 8. Article III of the Will provides: Independence Public Library, Independence, Iowa as a named beneficiary.
- 9. Funds payable to the "Independence Public Library" pass to the City of Independence, which do not necessarily benefit the Independence Public Library. In order for these funds to be distributed directly to the Library, the correct beneficiary designation would have been the "Independence Public Library Foundation".

COUNT 1: DISTRIBUTIONS TO INDEPENDENCE PUBLIC LIBRARY FOUNDATION

- 10. That Attorney A.J. Flickinger drafted the Will and confirmed that the "Independence Public Library Foundation" was the intended beneficiary listed in Article III of the Last Will and Testament of Mary Lou Cook. An Affidavit of Attorney A. J. Flickinger is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 11. That the City of Independence consents to this bequest to the "Independence Public Library Foundation, Independence, Iowa." See consent attached hereto as Exhibit C.
- 12. That the Executor requests a Declaratory Judgment to construe and determine the terms of the Will.
- 13. That the Executor requests the Court construe Article III of the Last Will and Testament of Mary Lou Cook to show "Independence Public Library Foundation," Independence, Iowa as a named beneficiary, as opposed to "Independence Public Library."

REQUEST FOR DECLARATORY RELIEF

- 14. The Executor incorporates paragraphs 1 through 13 by reference as though fully stated herein.
- 15. The Executor requests the Court issue a declaratory judgment to replace Independence Public Library, Independence, Iowa with "Independence Public Library Foundation, Independence, Iowa" in Article III.

WHEREFORE, Terri L. Wunder Cook, Executor of the Estate of Mary Lou Cook, prays for an order interpreting the terms of the Mary Lou Cook Last Will and Testament regarding distribution to the "Independence Public Library Foundation, Independence, Iowa" and for any further relief the court deems appropriate.

Last Will and Testament of

MARY LOU COOK

I, MARY LOU COOK, of Buchanan County, Iowa, being of sound mind, full age and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this instrument to be my Last Will and Testament, and revoke all former Wills and Codicils heretobefore made by me.

ARTICLE I.

I direct that all of my debts, including the expense of my last illness and funeral, and all inheritance, estate, or other similar taxes, be paid as provided by the law of the State of Iowa.

ARTICLE II.

I give, devise and bequeath my personal property and household goods located inside my Oakview apartment and storage area to my daughter, TERRI L. COOK WUNDER, or to her lineal descendants, per stirpes, if she does not survive me.

ARTICLE III.

I give, devise and bequeath all of the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal or mixed, wherever situated and whether acquired before or after the execution of this Will as follows: Fifty (50%) percent to my daughter, TERRI L. COOK WUNDER, or to her lineal descendants, per stirpes, if she does not survive me; Twenty-Five (25%) percent to be divided among the following named charities or institutions in the memory of ROBERT C. COOK and MARY LOU COOK: Camp Courageous, Monticello, Iowa; Hospice of Buchanan County, Iowa; Iowa Public TV, to be used for Nature Programing; Independence Public Library, Independence, Iowa; and East Buchanan Funds for the Future for scholarships given in the name

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF MARY LOU COOK Page Two of ROBERT C. COOK and MARY LOU COOK. In the event that any of the above named entities are not in existence at the time of my death, the other entities shall receive a prorata share. The remaining Twenty-Five (25%) percent share I give to my son, TIMOTHY F. COOK, or in the event he does not survive me, his share shall be divided among the above named charities or institutions, equally.

ARTICLE IV.

I nominate and appoint my daughter, TERRI L. COOK WUNDER, as Executor. If for any reason she shall fail to act or cease to qualify, I nominate and appoint MARK GEERTSMA as First Successor-Executor. If for any reason he shall fail to act or cease to qualify, I nominate and appoint BANKIOWA, Independence, Iowa, as Second Successor Executor of this Will. I further direct that no bond shall be required of my Executor or Successor-Executor. I give my Executor or Successor-Executor the power to sell or retain all or any part of my property, real or personal, on such terms and conditions as they may deem advisable, without necessity of any appraisal, Order of Court, or Notice to any person.
