Fuel Sales Update

- 100LL – 639 gal
- Jet A – 725 gal.

- Grounds:
 - Removed a tree on the South end of the Airport. The FAA will need to do a flight test to inspect all the lights at the airport. I did not want this to be an issue for the flight check. This tree was not very big. I would rather be safe and make sure they don't need to come back again.

- Equipment:
 - We have started working on snow equipment. The wiring harness on the small truck plow needed to be replaced. Went to Future Line and received new parts. Everything is wired up and ready to go.
 - We have spent some time working on the big mower getting it cleaned up and going through it before putting this away for the season.

- Miscellaneous:
 - I was able to find signs to put on the North Apron Gates just as it is on the other two gates to say (Aircraft Operations Area) I was able to put a no outlet sign on the fence where the road stops.
 - The lighting project is all finished up other than a sign that was not right and the seeding.
 - We were able to scrap all the wire and the lights from the lighting project all together this generated \$6,281.79 that will go back to the Airport (CIP) to help with funding future projects.
