RESOLUTION NO. 2024-C-008

WHEREAS, substance abuse and inadequate mental health services persist in the Indianapolis community; and

WHEREAS, City desires to address, reduce, treat, and prevent substance abuse and the deleterious effects of inadequate mental health services in Indianapolis; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Metropolitan Development, with funding provided through the national Opioid Settlement Fund, desires to enter into an Agreement with Circle Area Community Development Corporation for the St George Bridge Housing, to assist City efforts to provide recovery services and programs related to Substance Abuse Disorder and bridge housing to permanent supportive housing; and

WHEREAS, the national Opioid Settlement Fund has published a List of Opioid Remediation Uses to include programs and facilities that provide supportive housing for persons suffering from Substance Abuse Disorder, and

WHEREAS, Circle Area Community Development Corporation and their subcontractors are qualified to deliver the housing and services necessary to expand supportive housing and recovery services for persons suffering from Substance Abuse Disorder.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Department of Metropolitan Development is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with Circle Area Community Development Corporation to provide bridge housing for people who are experiencing homelessness and/or suffering from Substance Abuse Disorder in an amount not to exceed \$861,200.51.
