## Office of Emergency Management Update

OEM staff have been working with the Federal Emergency Management Administration and Texas Division of Emergency Management in regard to reimbursement of funds expended during Hurricane Beryl. On February 28, staff was notified that our reimbursement request of \$212,421.55 was approved by FEMA. We are currently working with TDEM for approval of the remaining amount of \$70,807.18. These funds were expended on our debris hauling and monitoring contracts.

We soon expect to receive approval of reimbursement of other Hurricane Beryl funds from FEMA.
