**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF IOWA COLONY,
TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A CRIMINAL
JUSTICE GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR,
PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, AND
AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY ACTIONS FOR THE
IMPLEMENTATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE GRANT**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Iowa Colony, Texas the City of Iowa Colony seek funds for the purchase of updated two-way radios through the Radio Update Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas further finds that it is in the best interest of the City to agree to abide by terms and conditions of the Criminal Justice Division grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas agrees that in the event of any loss or misuse of the grant funds provided pursuant to the Criminal Justice Grant Program, the City of Iowa Colony assures that such funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF IOWA COLONY, TEXAS:**

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas designates the Police Chief, Aaron I. Bell, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas designates Accountant, Amber Yaws, as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
