Finance Director Chris Thomas presented the proposed budget to City Council.

13. Consideration and possible action to propose a tax rate by a record vote.

Motion made by Councilmember Hargroder that the City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas, by record vote, propose a Fiscal Year 2026–2027 tax rate of \$0.54 per \$100 of taxable valuation, and further set a public hearing on the proposed tax rate for 7:00 p.m. on Monday, September 21, 2026, to be held in the City Council Chambers at Iowa Colony City Hall, 3144 Meridiana Parkway, Iowa Colony, Texas, Seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Greene-Scott. Motion made by Councilmember Hargroder that the City Council approve the Agreement between the City and MUD 55 regarding the design, permitting, financing, installation, and operation of a permanent natural gas generator for the Phase 1 Permanent Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) and within 2 years of this agreement and provide temporary diesel generator agreement prior to acceptance of the WWTP, Seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Greene-Scott.
