Ms. Newton,

I recommend Executive Council approval of payment in the amount of \$106,023.07 for special tax assessments against State owned land under the jurisdiction of the Iowa Department of Natural Resources located in the counties of Allamakee, Calhoun, Clay, Des Moines, Dickinson, Fremont Hancock, Harrison, Howard, Humboldt, Jackson, Kossuth, Louisa, Mills, Monona, Muscatine, Pocahontas, Pottawattamie, Van Buren, Winnebago, Woodbury, Worth and Wright.

Please note that the payment will be for drainage assessments pursuant to Iowa Code section 468.43.

Finally, please note that I identified a potential issue with the assessment for \$21.51 from Mills County which is shown on the second invoice from Mills County. As such, this amount has been removed from the spreadsheet attached resulting in the revised total above. Also, please find the tax statement from Mills County with this amount red-lined. This issue is being investigated, and once State ownership is confirmed, this amount will then be submitted.
