In accordance with Executive Council policy, we have examined the claim for 29C.20 funds for the above-mentioned damage. It is our conclusion that the above-mentioned damage incurred by University of Iowa – Board of Regents is covered by Chapter 29C.20 of the Code of Iowa. The University requested an allocation and reimbursement of \$586,014.77; however, one of the vendor invoices included sales tax of \$22.71. This amount will be deducted from the University's request. Therefore, we recommend an Executive Council allocation and reimbursement in the amount of \$585,992.06. This represents <u>full</u> and <u>final</u> payment of the loss.
