On 4-18-23, Motorola provided an update to 29C20 Tracking Spreadsheet advising the repair estimate regarding the damage to the Sioux ISICS Tower is \$8,722.00. Repairs will commence when tower crews become available.

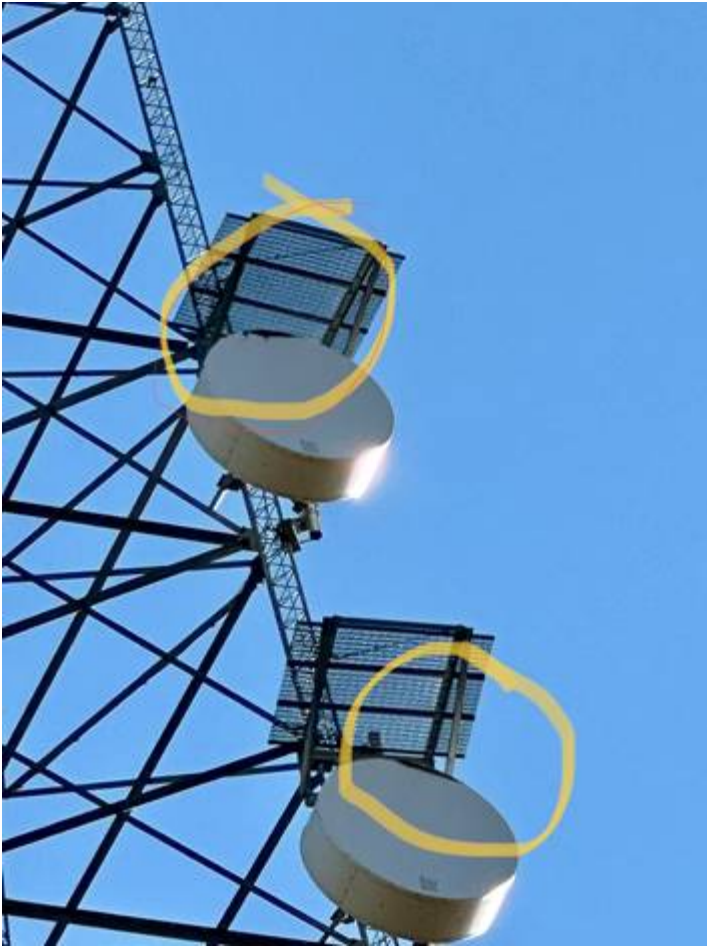
