AON 29C20 revised allocation request ref. Tama ISICS tower broken antenna

State of Iowa Executive Council:

On 5-21-24 several ISICS towers sustained tornado damage. In the days following the initial notification, ISICS and Motorola personnel inspected the towers for damage. The damage found includes a broken antenna at the Tama ISICS tower. A previous allocation request was submitted on 8-14-24 for \$9,500.

Motorola Warranty Representative Dave Gordon informed the DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau the initial estimate of \$9,500 will not be sufficient to cover the antenna replacement costs. He provided a revised estimate of \$22,500 for replacement of the broken antenna.

The DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau is respectfully submitting a revised 29C20 Allocation Request for \$22,500 regarding this act of nature damage.
