Duties of the State Board of Canvassers

§43.63 – The state board of canvassers shall review the results compiled by the secretary of state and, if the results are accurately tabulated, the state board shall approve the canvass.

• Sign one Election Canvass Summary – Sign at canvass normally; due to teleconference, this will be included in a box sent to offices for signatures after the canvass.

§43.68 – The state board of canvassers shall prepare and certify separate lists of the candidates nominated by each party, as shown by the state canvass, and deliver to the chairperson of each party central committee for the state a copy of the list of candidates nominated by the party which said chairperson represents.

§43.69 – The state board shall, at once after completing its canvass, prepare separate certificates for each political party as to each office for which no candidate was nominated by such party. Such certificates shall show the names of the several candidates for each of these offices who were voted for at the primary election and the number of votes received by each of said candidates. These certificates shall be sent to the respective chairpersons of the state central committee of each political party.

Sign three original No Candidate Nominated lists for each party prepared along respective race summaries; one to keep on file with canvass materials and two to be sent to the respective parties

 Sign at canvass normally; due to teleconference, this will be included in a box sent to offices for signatures after the canvass.

§50.39 – Make an abstract stating the number of ballots cast for each office, the names of all the persons voted for, for what office, the number of votes each received, and whom the state board of canvassers declares to be elected; which abstract shall be signed by the canvassers in their official capacity and as state canvassers, and have the seal of the state affixed.

 One Abstract prepared for each race for a total of 290 abstracts to be signed – Included in a box sent to offices for signatures after the canvass.

The State Canvass Summary file prepared for canvass board review includes: Winner List, List of Offices for Which No Candidate Was Nominated, Voter Turnout Report, Official Result Totals broken down by county, and a Primary Election voter turnout comparison chart that includes the 2022, 2020, 2018 and 2016 Primary Elections for the Democratic and Republican Parties. County abstracts and canvass summary materials with precinct breakdowns also are available for review upon request.
