Running cold water into the boilers is a very bad and dangerous and inefficient process as they boilers are trying to heat cold water. This condensate tank is critical to the operation of the boilers that heat the facility.

The tank needs replaced completely as it has developed a significant holes and is beyond repair. The tank is over 100 years old.

Estimates at this time for the purchase, install and repairs are listed below:

Per DAS Major Maintenance (Samuels Group): \$350,000.
