Re: Change of Special Counsel Request – Tribal Land

Dear Victoria:

Our office previously retained Special Counsel, Michael Marquess to represent the State of Iowa in criminal crimes committed when the offenses are committed by non-natives against non-natives (or without a victim) on the Sac and Fox Indian Settlement in Tama County. Mr. Marquess provided us his resignation as he is starting his new position as Magistrate Judge in Marshall County as of March 2023.

We would like to request Thomas L. Hillers of Hillers Legal, P.C., 112 W Main St Suite 100, State Center, IA 50247 to represent the State of Iowa in these matters. Hillers will provide services at a monthly retainer of \$5,000 per month for an initial term from March 20, 2023, until June 30, 2023. This is identical to Mr. Marquess' contract terms. The partial month of March will be pro-rated and paid in the amount of \$1,935.

Here is some background on this request: A 1948 act of Congress granted the State of Iowa jurisdiction over all criminal offenses committed on the Settlement. A recent act of Congress returned to tribal authorities the criminal jurisdiction of crimes committed on the Settlement by or against natives. The issue has become - who should bear the cost of prosecution of crimes committed by non-natives on the Settlement, which is considered a sovereign nation? Tama County officials believe the costs of bringing these criminal cases on behalf of the State of Iowa should be borne by the State of Iowa, not Tama County.

The Office believes alleged crimes committed by non-natives on the Settlement should be diligently prosecuted. In the interest of public safety and equal administration of justice, the Office agrees that it is appropriate to pay these costs from the General Fund, as described above.
