On 3-31-26 Motorola personnel discovered radome damage to the Maquoketa ISICS tower. High winds and severe storms are believed to have caused this damage.

Motorola Warranty Representative Dave Gordon was able to provide the DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau with an estimate of \$9,800 for repairs to the tower. Repairs will commence once a tower crew becomes available.
