#### 6. Emergency Allocations

Moved by Secretary Pate and seconded by Secretary Naig that the Executive Council approve the following emergency allocation requests:

- A. Board of Regents Iowa State University requested an emergency allocation and reimbursement in the amount of \$262,515.17. On October 20, 2023, Marson Hall was damaged by a fire. Request was to cover repair costs. This represents full and final payment and this allocation will be closed.
- B. Department of Administrative Services requested an emergency allocation in the amount of \$42,578.24. On January 16, 2024, the Jessie Parker Building suffered structural water damages due to excessively cold temperatures and a ruptured water line. Request was to cover repair costs.
- C. Department of Administrative Services requested a supplemental emergency allocation in the amount of \$594.60. This brings the total allocation to \$10,737.65. On June 22, 2024, Vehicle #314 was damaged by a deer. Request was to cover repair costs. This represents full and final payment and this allocation will be closed.

- D. Department of Administrative Services requested an emergency allocation in the amount of \$3,261.50. On September 9, 2024, Vehicle #319 was damaged by a deer. Request was to cover repair costs.
