In accordance with Executive Council policy, we have examined the claim for 29C.20 funds for the above-mentioned damage. It is our conclusion that the above damage incurred by the Department of Public Safety – Iowa State Patrol is covered by Chapter 29C.20 of the Code of Iowa. The Department requested an allocation and reimbursement in the amount of \$14,003.11; however, the estimate from the vendor includes sales tax of \$25.47. This amount will be deducted from the Department's request. Therefore, we recommend an Executive Council allocation and reimbursement in the amount of \$13,977.64.
