On 1-14-26, Iowa DPS personnel discovered radome damage on the Beaverdale ISICS tower. High winds are believed to have caused this damage.

Motorola Warranty Representative Dave Gordon was able to provide the DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau with an estimate of \$9,800 for repairs to the tower. Repairs will commence once a tower crew becomes available.

The DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau is respectfully submitting a 29C.20 allocation request for \$9,800 regarding this act of nature damage.
