AON 29C.20 allocation request ref. diversity dish damage at the Adams County ISICS tower

State of Iowa Executive Council:

On 4-8-2025 Motorola Customer Support Manager Dave Gordon inspected the Adams County ISICS tower and discovered a diversity dish (radome) had fallen from the tower and landed on the ground causing damage. This damage is believed to have been caused by high wind events in the area.


