Ref. AON 29C20 Revised Allocation Request for 2-21-23 AON Radome Damage to the Sioux ISICS Communication Tower caused by flying debris

State of Iowa Executive Council:

During the 2-21-23 Bi-weekly Motorola Warranty Update Conference Call, Dave Gordon, Motorola Customer Support Manager, advised that high winds caused flying debris to break the radome cover on the Sioux ISICS Communication Tower. On 2-21-23, an initial 29C20 notification was sent to the Executive Council regarding this Act of Nature (AON) Damage to the Sioux ISICS tower site (See attached email).

On 4-18-23, Motorola provided an update to 29C20 Tracking Spreadsheet advising the repair estimate regarding the damage to the Sioux ISICS Tower is \$8,722.00. Repairs will commence when tower crews become available.

On 4-18-23 the DPS Interoperability and Communications Bureau had submitted a 29C20 Allocation Request for \$8,722.00 regarding this AON damage.

On the morning of 9-20-23, a Motorola Tower repair crew arrived at the ISICS Sioux Tower site to replace the radome that was reported damaged on 2-21-23; however, when they arrived they discovered an additional two radome covers had been damaged due to AON flying debris (See attached email string and photos of additional damaged radomes). We assume it occurred on 2-21-23 but was initially reported as one dish.

Please adjust the previous 4-18-23 29C20 Allocation request to reflect 3 damaged dishes for an estimated repair cost of \$26,166.00

Sioux Site Storm Damage Report

On 2-21-23 and on 9-20-23 there were reports of broken dish covers at the ISICS Sioux Site. These sustained weather related damage.

Sioux Tower Damage

Three of the dishes on the tower sustained damage from a weather related event/storm.

Secondary 6ft dish facing the Rock Rapids site.

Primary 6ft dish facing the Plymouth site.

Secondary 6ft dish facing the Plymouth site.

Facing Rock Rapids Site

The secondary dish facing the Rock Rapids site had to have the dish radome cover replaced.

The dish was removed from the tower and lowered to the ground. Then a new cover was installed on the dish. The dish then had to be raised back up the tower and re mounted. The dish was aligned back into specifications.



Facing Plymouth Site

The primary and secondary dish facing the Plymouth site had to have the dish radome covers replaced.

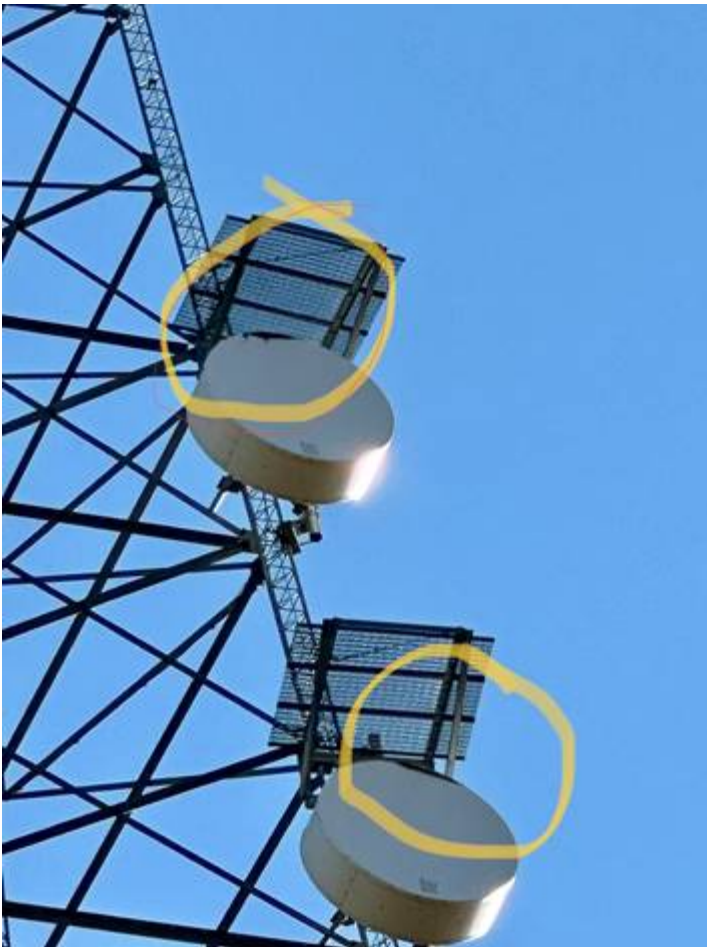
