State of Iowa Executive Council:

On 3-6-24, Dave Gordon, Motorola Customer Support Manager, was driving past the Mitchellville ISICS tower and noticed a broken radome cover. He advised he was at the tower on 2-29-24 and there were not broken covers. The damage had to have occurred between 3-1-24 and 3-6-24. Over that time period there were high wind events in the area.
