State of Iowa Executive Council:

On March 18, a Motorola technician was conducting their duties and reported a damaged radome on the Ringgold ISICS tower. This damage occurred during the blizzard event on March 5, 2025. When the tower crew arrived to begin repairs, they observed a second broken radome. This radome was most likely damaged during the same blizzard event on March 5, 2025.

Dave Gordon was able to provide the DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau a revised estimate of \$15,000 for repairs to both broken radomes and ice shield. Repairs have commenced and an invoice will be available soon.

The DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau is respectfully submitting a revised 29C.20 allocation request for \$15,000 regarding this act of nature damage.

They happen to have two with them and we will have them replace both.


