In accordance with Executive Council policy, we have examined the supplemental request for 29C.20 funds for the above-mentioned damage. The Department of Public Safety has requested a supplemental allocation of \$46,321.73, which increases the total allocation to \$61,607.73. It is our conclusion that the above-mentioned damage and additional costs incurred by the Department are covered by Chapter 29C.20 of the Code of Iowa. Therefore, we recommend an Executive Council allocation and reimbursement in the amount of \$46,321.73. An additional payment request will be submitted by the Department for reimbursement of the remaining allocation.
