State of Iowa Executive Council:

On 4-2-23, Motorola submitted an invoice for \$26,889.09 regarding Act of Nature (AON) damage repairs to the Brooklyn ISICS Tower site. The damage to the Brooklyn ISICS tower occurred sometime between 12-22-22 and 12-24-22 when strong winds damaged one of the tower's antennas.

The DPS Interoperability Communications Bureau is respectfully submitting a 29C20 Reimbursement Claim for \$26,889.09 for this AON damage. Brooklyn Lightning Damage Report

On December 30st, 2022 there was a report of an antenna sideways on the Brooklyn tower. The report was confirmed with photos.

Motorola had requested an emergency tower crew to investigate the antenna on December 31st, 2022. The tower crew found that the antenna mounting brackets bent and twisted. In order to prevent further damage to the tower and site the tower crew stabilized the antenna with rope to the tower. An antenna mounting kit was ordered.

On January 12th, 2023 the tower crew and technician returned to the site with a new mounting kit. When they started to install the new mounting kit they found that the antenna had lightning damage. They also found damage to the connector on the antenna.

On January 13th, 2023 Motorola was able to rent a truck and get a spare antenna from Cedar Rapids to the site. A technician was able to get replacement connectors in Des Moines. The tower crew was able to install the new mounting kit and spare antenna and connectors on the tower.

Once the work was complete the technician tested the system and everything tested normal.

Please accept this email as the initial notification of AON Damage to the ISICS Brooklyn Tower Antenna. Sometime between 12-22 and 12-24-22, during the statewide blizzard with strong wind advisory, the north antenna on the Brooklyn ISICS Tower was blown sideways and is out of alignment. The report was received by the DOT from a former employee who noticed the issue and reported it. On 12-30-22, Motorola sent a tower crew and the damage was confirmed. Motorola will schedule the repairs and an estimate will be sent upon receipt.
