Sec. 5-7. Consumption of alcoholic beverages in public places and public intoxication.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink intoxicating liquor or nonintoxicating beer upon the public streets, parking lots, alleys, highways, thoroughfares, or sidewalks within the city unless the city has issued appropriate permits for activities that allow consumption at specific events.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to be in an intoxicated condition upon the public streets, parking lots, alleys, highways, thoroughfares, or sidewalks within the city. A person is in an intoxicated condition when he or she is under the influence of alcohol, a controlled substance, or drug, or any combination thereof, so as to be impaired in his or her ability to safely walk in the areas set forth in this subsection.
