RE: TEAP Grant Application

MoDOT recently announced the availability of funding through the Traffic Engineering Assistance Program (TEAP). TEAP funds allow local public agencies to receive engineering assistance for studying traffic engineering problems such as pedestrian safety. TEAP funds can cover up to 80% of a project cost, up to \$12,000. Staff is proposing to apply for TEAP funds for the study of Main Street from West Jackson Boulevard to Hope Street. The purpose of the study would be to identify possible solutions to improve the safety of pedestrians traveling along and crossing Main Street. In order to submit the application by the due date of September 23rd, 2022, a resolution would need to be passed at the September 6th Mayor and Board of Aldermen meeting.
