Subject: ISO Class 3 Rating

Dear Mayor Hahs and Members of the Board of Aldermen,

It is with great pleasure to inform you that the City of Jackson's Public Protection Classification from ISO (Insurance Services Office) has dropped from a Class 4/4X to a Class 3/3X that will be effective May 1, 2023.

The purpose of this periodic survey and evaluation is to gather information that determines this classification, which insurers use for underwriting and calculation of premiums for fire insurance. During this process, they are looking at features that directly relate to the reduction of property losses from fire events. These features include:

- 10% Emergency Communications
- 40% Water Supply
- 50% Fire Department
- +5% Community Risk Reduction

2023- Class 3
