SUBJECT: Uptown ADA Parking

The City has been approached by two individuals with separate ADA parking requests for the uptown area. One was a request for an additional ADA space in front of the History Center. The other was a request for ADA parking at Adams Street near the Ground-a-Bout.

City staff reviewed the requests and recommends the Board consider the following ADA parking changes which are shown on the attached map.

1. Relocate the existing handicap parking space on South High Street by the former bank building to the east side of the street adjacent to the existing ADA space. This allows a safer location for accessible entrance and exit from the vehicle.
2. Add two ADA parking spaces with a shared loading zone in the city-owned lot across the street from the Ground-a-Bout. This would take up three of the existing parking spaces, but because the lot has 30 parking spaces, two accessible spaces are required for ADA compliance.

If the Board is in agreement with either or both of these, we will prepare an ordinance for the next regular meeting date.
