RE: City Hall Access Controls and Cameras

In an effort to improve security at City Hall, we have obtained a quote from KT Power to install door access controls and security cameras. The project would include door controls at the main employee entrance, a video intercom system with door controls at the Missouri Street entrance that would allow UJRO staff to remotely open the door on Missouri Street, a door access control on the future door that would separate the main lobby from the rest of City Hall once constructed, card readers on the elevator, 8 new security cameras and updated configuration of our 8 existing security cameras. The proposed door access control system is the same as the systems currently in use at the JPD and at both stations of the JFR. The cards can be cross-programmed and compatible at any of the locations, as needed.

The cost from KT Power is \$27,245.29. With the work on the elevator, an employee from OTIS Elevator will need to be onsite, and that cost is an additional \$5,560.90 for a total project cost of \$32,806.19.
