**Re:** Improvement Options for Jackson City Pool

The Jackson City Pool will celebrate its 50<sup>th</sup> birthday when it opens for the summer 2026 season. The facility, built in 1976 to replace the 1938 pool, continues to provide enjoyment for all ages as well as life skills through swim lessons. The pool and bathhouse have seen deterioration over the years due to normal wear and tear, combined with accelerated wear from chemicals used to treat the water.

In the summer of 2025, a task order was issued to the engineering firm of Bacon Farmer Workman along with aquatic consultant Brandstetter Carroll to provide options for renovation and/or replacement of the City Pool. The results of the task order have been provided for your review.
