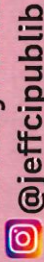

Bring your own mat. Beginner friendly!

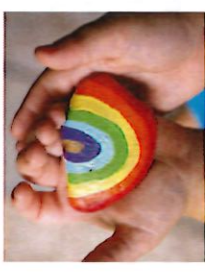
