Join us for popcorn and refreshments as we watch the 2012 film Hotel Transylvania. Everyone is welcome, and as always, it's FREE!



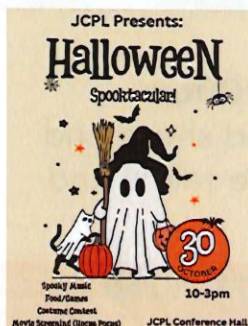
Paranormal Investigators "Lost Souls in the Shadows":
