To all municipalities within Jefferson County:

As you know, Jefferson County Sanitation is experiencing an overfull condition on the Class III/IV Construction and Demolition side of its landfill. Due to this ongoing overfilled status, the Jefferson County Sanitation Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the longevity of residential disposal for each city's public works department to begin taking their Class III/IV waste to the Lakeway Sanitation Landfill in Morristown. Each city has until **August 1**<sup>st</sup> to complete this waste transfer, and it will remain in effect until further notice. We are aware of the inconveniences this transfer will cause, but it has become necessary to extend disposal ability for the citizens of Jefferson County as a whole. We are actively working with the State of Tennessee and all affiliated parties on a resolution, and we will notify you when we have updates.
