A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A 2026 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO FUND COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program as administered by the State of Tennessee offers grants to local jurisdiction to fund community infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, Counties and municipalities within the State of Tennessee may apply annually for such CDBG funding; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program also offers a deduction in the percentage match for three-star communities; and

WHEREAS, the Three Star incentive makes the 2026 CDBG match for Jefferson City \$176,471.00 based on a \$1,000,000.00 CDBG grant limit; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson City will apply for the CDBG grant to fund a Community Infrastructure project.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Jefferson City hereby requests the Mayor or his representatives to prepare and submit a 2026 Community Development Block Grant application for funding up to the maximum amount of \$1,000,000.00 (CDBG) funds with a local match of \$176,471.00 for a total project cost of \$1,176,471.00.
