#### **Education, Summer Semester:**

- Thursday February 8<sup>th,</sup> we withheld our training due to bad weather.

#### **Department Affairs and On-going Projects**

- Our February call volume is up by 12 over last February's 29 calls, totaling 41 calls this month. Our Fire Department personnel are performing their tasks in a professional manner with no injuries occurring.
- February 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th we had our annual Fire extinguisher servicing. This year due to weather conditions the 8<sup>th</sup> was rescheduled to the 28<sup>th</sup>. Many locals used the opportunity and were able to get new and refurbished extinguishers.
- The Annual NAEMS Grant is coming up shortly and we are beginning our application process. We use this grant to assist in restocking needed medical supplies as well as mitigating the cost of EMT refresher training for our EMT's.
- We have received a grant for \$120,000, This grant is for Incident Management software as well as laptops. We are currently working with 3AM Innovations and are awaiting finalizations. The software is about \$30,000 and we will be able to purchase hardware such as Laptops, Phones and Vehicle Integration. Everything has been approved and we are now receiving some items, as of the 29<sup>th</sup> we have received new phones, and the vehicle mounts.
- Jerome Fire's New Drone was recently damaged and is being replaced though the initial company. A new one should hopefully be sent to us shortly.
- We have completed the setup for out of district emergency response subscriptions, they are made available to out-of-town limits residences and businesses, The subscription makes it more financially equitable for residences and businesses that are outside of town limits. We have already received several paid subscriptions.

#### Prevention

- We have had a total of 16 Firewise activities and visits to the burn pile in February with 49 loads of trimmings, slash, and brush for a total of 29 combined Jerome's citizen hours. As well as 44 total hours from our Fuels Crew. We currently have a crew of 2 Firewise personnel.
- If you need assistance, please fill out a Firewise application, applications can be obtained at the Town Hall or the Fire Department.
- 12 Business license inspections performed.

Thank you to all Jerome residents and property owners that have helped create defensible space around their properties by removing dead and overgrown trees, brush, and grasses.
