

DEPTH OF SERVICE

Palm Beach County Fire Rescue has 51 Fire Stations with 171 front line units Units move-up to other areas regularly for coverage

- 55 ALS Rescues each staffed with 3 people
- 45 ALS Engines 42 staffed with 3 people, 3 staffed with 4 people
- 6 ALS Aerials each staffed with 4 people
- 2 Special Operations Units each staffed with 2 people
- 4 Tenders each staffed with 1 person
- 4 Personal Rescue Watercrafts
- 11 District Chiefs
- 9 10 Battalion Chiefs (24-7, 365 days per year)
- **9** 10 EMS Captains (24-7, 365 days per year)

- 9 1 Light/Air Truck
- 9 19 Brush Trucks
- 4 ARFF Vehicles

EVOLUTION OF EMS SERVICES

- Response to outbreaks and pandemics
 - Mobile testing, vaccinations, dispatch screening, telemedicine
- Response to Opioid Crisis
 - MIH (LCSWs and paramedics), DOH and HCD
- Whole Blood & Plasma/Ultrasound/Finger Thoracostomy
 - Bring the trauma center to the point of injury
- Pediatric and adult grief support services
 - Follow the patient and their family through our MIH Services

EVOLUTION OF ALL HAZARD SERVICES

- Personal Rescue Watercraft (6 total)
 - Search and rescue open water
- Airboat (2 total)
 - Search and rescue in wetlands
- Swiftwater Boats (4 total)
 - Flood water rescue
- Urban Search and Rescue (USAR)
 - Only team in Palm Beach County

 - Community Risk Reduction
