5 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JUNO BEACH,
6 FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
7 COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023;
8 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE;
9 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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11 WHEREAS, Town Staff has determined that in accordance with applicable accounting
12 principles, and as required by state law, the Town must amend the annual budget for the fiscal
13 year commencing October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023 (“Fiscal Year 2022-2023”);

16 WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget to
17 provide for certain adjustments and amendments thereto.

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19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
20 OF JUNO BEACH, FLORIDA, as follows:

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22 Section 1. The foregoing recitals are ratified as true and incorporated herein.

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24 Section 2. The Town Council hereby approves the following budget adjustments as an
25 official amendment to the original budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023, as adopted on September
26 28, 2022:

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30 Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Juno Beach, Florida,
31 in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. To the extent
32 not modified herein, all other provisions of the Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 remain
33 in full force and effect.

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35 Section 4. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this
36 Ordinance is for any reason held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional,
37 inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

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39 Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
