15 16 17	WHEREAS, the Town Code neither provides standards for property subject to a demolition permit nor requires any notice of the issuance of such a permit to adjacent property owners; and
19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board recommended the adoption of an ordinance amending the Town Code to require that adjacent property owners be notified of any demolitions, and Town Staff recommended the imposition of additional standards and conditions; and
24 25 26	WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents and property owners of the Town of Juno Beach.

30 31 32 33	<b>Section 1.</b> The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified as true and confirmed and are incorporated herein.
34 35 36 37 38	<b>Section 2.</b> The Town Council hereby amends Article V, "Property Maintenance and Construction Standards," of Chapter 6, "Buildings and Building Regulations," of the Town Code of Ordinances by adopting a new Section 6-111 to read as follows (additional language is <u>underlined</u> ):
39	Sec. 6-111. Demolition permits.
40 41 42 43	Each application for a complete or major demolition permit shall be subject to the following standards and conditions:
44 45 46	(a) Existing native vegetation shall be preserved on site to the maximum extent practicable.
47 48	(b) An erosion control plan, parking plan, construction screening plan, and truck logistics plan shall be submitted with the permit

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1 application. 2 3 (c) The property owner shall submit an affidavit, in a format prescribed by the town, confirming that notice has been provided 4 5 to the owners of all properties located within three hundred (300) feet of the property on which the demolition will occur at least 6 7 fourteen (14) days and no more than thirty (30) days prior to any demolition activities 8 9 10 <u>(d)</u> If construction does not commence within thirty (30) days after the demolition or a permit for reconstruction expires or otherwise 11 becomes null and void, the property owner shall sod and irrigate 12 the property within ten (10) business days to assure that the 13 property will have a neat and clean landscaped appearance and 14 will not be deemed a nuisance. 15 16 17 Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Juno Beach. 18 19 If any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any 20 paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, 21 22 such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. 23 All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Juno Beach, Florida, Section 5. 24 25 which are in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. 26 27 Section 6.
