Hello Mr. Brownman

I am reviewing an RFQ submitted by APTIM and they listed you as a reference for a VA they completed for the Town of Longboat Key.

Would you briefly explain the VA plan they created for your town and if it was successfully accepted by the state of Florida?

APTIM conducted a four (4) phase vulnerability assessment, which included establishing an initial baseline and projection (this was before the State of FL established certain thresholds), a very large amount of data collection, an infrastructure and property vulnerability assessment, and recommendations with external funding sources to consider. The assessment was also updated while in progress to include the state baselines that were established a few years ago.

Was the team with APTIM available when you needed them and did they successfully coordinate the public meetings required by the state statute?

Yes.

Did they meet all the task dates?

Yes.

What was the final cost of the VA for your city?

Phase 1 "Initial Assessment": \$50,000

Phase 2 "Data Collection and Analysis": \$175,000

Phase 3 "Adaptation Strategy Development": \$77,000

Phase 4 "Implementation Plan with Recommendations and Funding Opportunities": \$54,000

Total: \$356,000

This effort began with Phase 1 in 2018 and concluded with Phase 4 in 2023. The timeframe was due to how the Town could afford funding the components of project, some of which we accomplished through grants and most with Town money.

I hope you are doing well.

I am happy to provide feedback on my experience with APTIM.

Would you briefly explain the VA plan they created for your city and if it was successfully accepted by the state of Florida? We are in the process of developing the VA plan, so I am unable to provide this information.

Was the team with APTIM available when you needed them and did they successfully coordinate the public meetings required by the state statute? I worked with APTIM to coordinate the public meetings (1 of 2 have been completed to date), but they were on top of developing a survey and helping us promote the project. They presented the introductory project details at the first Public Meeting and it was great information that explained the reason for this project very well. It was held at our Planning & Zoning Meeting held on June 26th.

Did they meet all the task dates? They have completed Task 1 for data gathering, and are working through the other tasks to complete the VA plan.

What was the final cost of the VA for your city? The bid amount was \$55,000, this was below the project funded amount.

Would you hire them again for this task if given the opportunity? Yes, I would hire them again. We are actually looking for their assistance on a GIS development project for which we will be seeking funding.

Q I am reviewing an RFQ submitted by BBC engineering and they listed you as a reference for a VA they completed for the City of Lauderdale.

Response Yes. BCC not only completed the Vulnerability Assessment but also were instrumental in helping the City get a grant from DEP for this study (about \$180,000.00)

Q Would you briefly explain the VA plan they created for your city and if it was successfully accepted by the state of Florida?

Response The VA identify the City's critical infrastructure and model future conditions under projected effects from the sea level rise. They model the City's current conditions and assess the effect of the storm events in a near future. Basically, almost all the City facilities were found to be at risk.

Q Was the team with BBC available when you needed them and did they successfully coordinate the public meetings required by the state statute?

R Yes. They are responsive and knowledgeable.

Q Did they meet all the task dates?

R Yes. Although the estimated timeline was shorter and provided under normal circumstances, the delays resulted from DEP's review process.

Q What was the final cost of the VA for your city?

R about \$180,000.00
