5 A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JUNO
6 BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF JUNO
7 BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2023
8 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2024; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN
9 MANAGER TO TRANSFER MONIES AMONG LINE ITEMS IN THE
10 GENERAL FUND FOR AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURES; PROVIDING
11 FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Juno Beach, Florida has held a
14 series of budget meetings for the purpose of establishing a budget for the fiscal year
15 commencing October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024 (“Fiscal Year 2023-2034”);
16 and

18 WHEREAS, at a duly advertised public hearing held on September 13, 2023, the
19 Town Council adopted a tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 in the amount of
20 \$11,514,900; and

22 WHEREAS, at a duly advertised public hearing held on September 27, 2023, the
23 Town Council reviewed the tentative budget and determined that it will meet the needs
24 and requirements of the Town and its residents for Fiscal Year 2023-2024.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
27 TOWN OF JUNO BEACH, FLORIDA, as follows:

29 Section 1. The foregoing recitals are ratified as true and incorporated herein.
30

31 Section 2. The budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, a copy of which is attached
32 hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein, is hereby adopted as the annual budget for
33 the Town of Juno Beach, providing the revenue and expense for the items set forth in the
34 budget. The Town Council authorizes the Town Manager to amend the budget to transfer
35 monies among line items in the general fund for expenditures authorized by the Town
36 Council, provided, however, that any increase to the total amount of the budget may only
37 be authorized by resolution of the Town Council as required by law.

39 Section 3. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this
40 Resolution is for any reason held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be
41 unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of the
42 Resolution.

44 Section 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the Town of Juno Beach in
45 conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
