Good morning Steven,

If replacing plant material that was identified in the executed Landscape MMOA, it is considered a **maintenance** activity.
Therefore, a Landscape Permit is not required.

However, if *new* plant material is being installed that is *not* included in the executed Landscape MMOA, a Landscape Permit application would be required.

Please note that an MOT (Maintenance of Traffic) application is required for any lane closures or similar activities.
