Item Title:

Council to consider Roadway Striping on Fayetteville Road (Tara Boulevard to Smith Street) for safety Improvements.

Requested Action: Council to approve Roadway Striping on Fayetteville Road from Tara Boulevard to Smith Street.

Requirement for Board Action:

Is this Item Goal Related? Yes, Proper striping along this corridor will improve driver safety. Drivers will be able to clearly identify travel lanes, turn areas, and boundaries.

Summary and Background: Fayetteville Road currently lacks clearly visible roadway striping. This deficiency has created unsafe driving conditions for motorists. The absence of lane markings contributes to driver confusion, inconsistent lane usage, and an increased risk of accidents. This roadway segment experiences a high volume of traffic flow and serves as an important connector within the city.

Fiscal Impact: Cost of striping ranges from \$11,658.00 to \$18,035.00. Public Works line item 100-4100-52-2210 Street Maintenance currently has a budget balance of \$13,881.04
